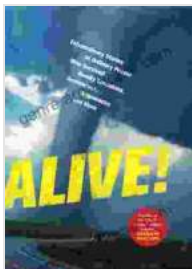

The El Reno Tornado

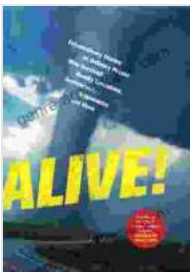
