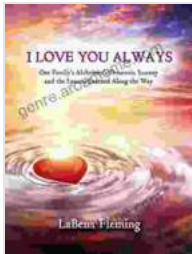

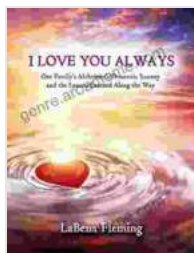

and ethical issues, and she has been praised for her ability to create complex and believable characters.

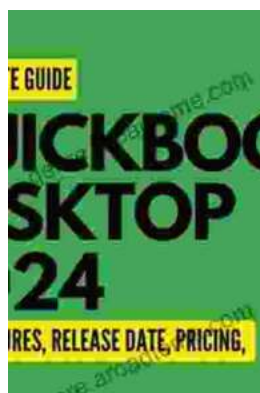


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
